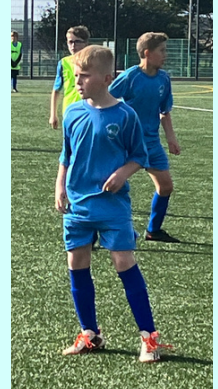


# Breage School Newsletter

# School Uniform

## Our School Uniform Policy

We believe school uniform is important: it looks smart; wears well; contributes to a sense of belonging and community; makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance; fosters a feeling of pride and is designed with health & safety in mind.

We ask that all children wear the uniform and encourage them to maintain a good standard of clean and tidy dress in school. The uniform is designed to be practical, maintainable and good value for money. From this academic year, we ask that school hoodies are used primarily for sports purposes. If your child has hoodies in place of sweatshirts which still fit, please do not feel you have to replace these immediately with a school sweatshirt. Hair accessories such as slides, ribbons, bobbles etc should be fairly simple and if possible in school colours. IMPORTANT: please ensure ALL items are labelled clearly with your child's name. For safety reasons we ask that children do not wear jewellery in school. For health reasons it is important that children are properly dressed for physical activity. All children should have a full PE kit.

**NEW THIS YEAR:** Uniform can be purchased locally from Whirlwind Sports, Meneage Street, Helston. Items will feature our new school logo. You will be able to browse items on their website (coming soon) and check if the garment and size required is in stock. If not in stock, it will only take days, not weeks, to arrive with the convenience of trying sizes in store as well. 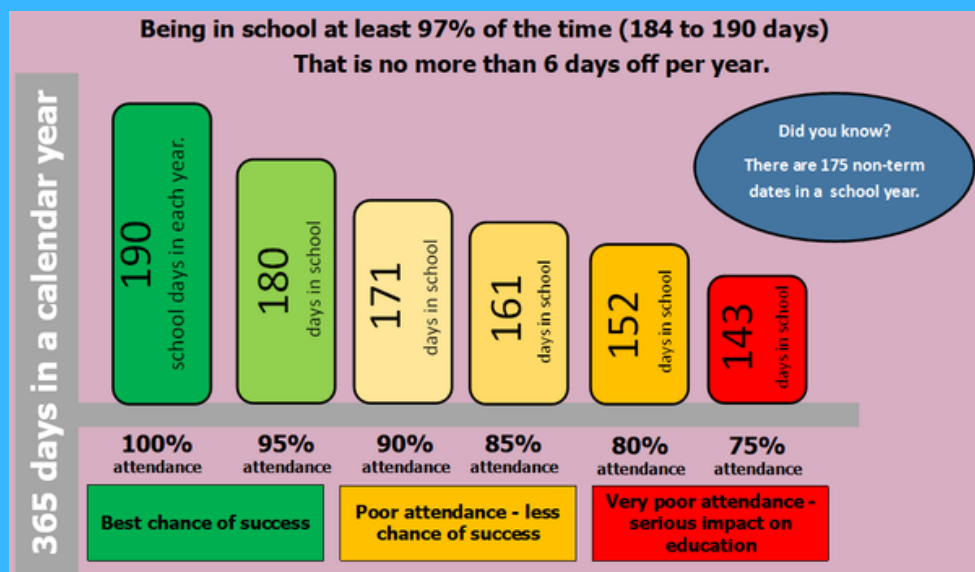
# Attendance

School is so important!

If your child is going to be absent from school for any reason, please inform the office as soon as possible. You can use our email [hello@breageschool.org](mailto:hello@breageschool.org) or select the attendance reporting option when you ring.

All children should arrive in school for 8.50am ready for registration and prompt lesson start at 9.00am. For safeguarding reasons our registers close at **9.05am**. If your child is absent and we are not aware of the reason, a text will be sent asking you to contact school.

This academic year, we will be sending home termly attendance certificates. You can also check your child's data, including attendance, using your Arbor login.



## Arbor - Parent Portal - IMPORTANT

85% of our parents have logged into their Arbor parent portal. Parents can view their child's attendance, check data and in some places make amendments eg change/add an email address. Within this login are also numerous consent requests - could parents please login asap and check if there are any outstanding tasks please. There are many children with outstanding consents. These will be checked again in a week and chase up's sent home. If you are a parent who is showing as not having logged in as yet, an email has been sent to you with instructions.





# We're using Arbor's free Parent Portal and Arbor App

We've chosen Arbor to help us manage our school.

Arbor is a simple, smart and cloud-based MIS (Management Information System), which helps us work faster, smarter and more collaboratively as a school. The Arbor App and Parent Portal mean we can keep you informed about your child's life at school in a much more accessible way. Log into Arbor to see and update your child's information, get live updates and make payments or bookings on the go!

The Parent Portal works on Google Chrome (computer or laptop) and you can download the Arbor App from the App Store or Google Play Store on your phone (Android 5.0; iOS 10.0 and upwards).

## How to get started

- 1.Wait for your welcome email from us telling you Arbor is ready - you won't be able to log in before
- 2.Click the link in your welcome email to set up your password
- 3.Go to the App or Google Play Store on your phone and search 'Arbor'
- 4.Click 'Install' on Android or 'Get' on iPhone then open the App
- 5.Enter your email, select the school, then enter your password
- 6.Accept the Terms & Conditions and enter your child's birthday

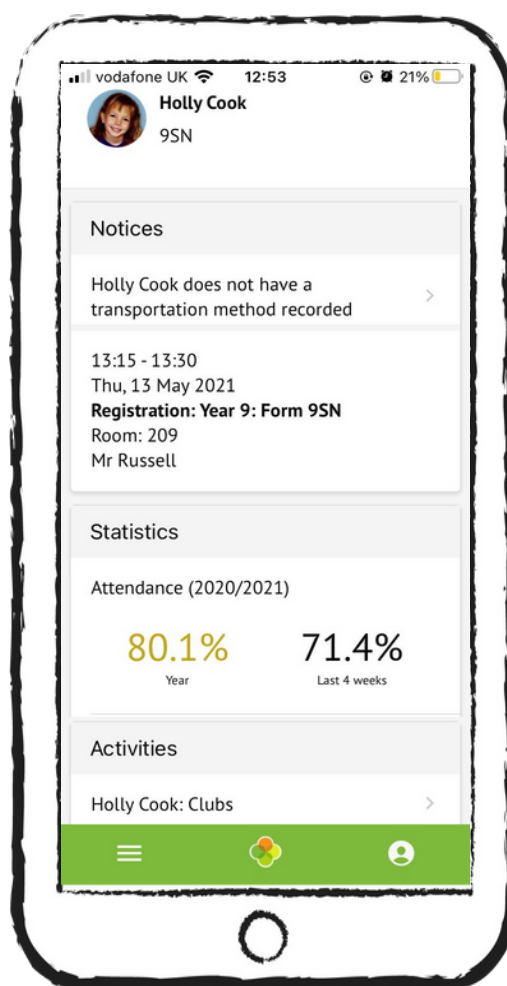
## Need help using Arbor?

Contact the school office if you have questions about Arbor, the App or Parent Portal. Tell us the type and model of your phone, e.g. an iPhone SE, and include screenshots or screen recordings.

To safeguard student data in line with General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR), Arbor only works directly with schools.

Some tips to try:

- 1.Ensure your username is the email address you use for Arbor. Ask us to check the email address linked to your account.
- 2.Reset your password from the login page, or ask us to do this.
- 3.If the login email was sent to you more than 96 hours ago, the password link will have expired. Ask us to send it again.
- 4.Ask the school office to check that your email address has not been used twice - e.g. on another guardian or child's profile.
- 5.Enter the birthday of one of your children to log in.
- 6.Only relatives who are **Primary Guardians** of a child can access the Arbor App. Ask us to check you can access Arbor.

# Information

## Blue Class Swimming Lessons

New for the Autumn term are the introduction of intensive swimming lessons as opposed to weekly lessons. These have been proven to increase children's water skills and confidence greatly in comparison to weekly lessons. Blue Class children will swim each school day over two weeks (w/c 09/10 and 16/10). Children will travel by minibus each day. Consent will be added to ParentPay soon. We would appreciate a contribution of £30 (£3 per lesson) per child (actual cost per child is £87.50 which is excluding transport).



## ParentPay

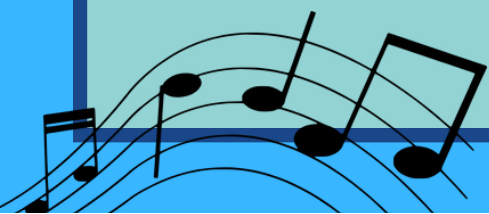
All children have a ParentPay account. Children's accounts can be joined (add child) so that you only have one login with multiple children accounts within it. Please login to your ParentPay account and clear any outstanding balances, PAFC, school meals, trips, nursery fees. Balances that cannot be cleared within a reasonable period, please email [hello@breageschool.org](mailto:hello@breageschool.org) to advise when we can expect payment (instalments acceptable for larger sums). This will avoid Aspire Trust intervening. School meals should be booked in advance on ParentPay. This shortens time spent in class during registration - allowing lessons to begin promptly.

# Information

## **Aspens Catering**

We say welcome to a new team of caterers this academic year and to Mr Parry who is in our servery daily.

The new Aspens menu is on ParentPay and all lunches should be chosen in advance - parents should pre-book their child(ren)'s meals. This ensures children have a meal of their liking ordered and speeds up time spent on this in class during registration. When ordering you have to select one main meal option, tick the vegetable shown and then choose a pudding option. Each school meal will cost £2.65. Home packed lunches should contain healthy options and children are encouraged to bring in a piece of fruit for morning break (Reception, Year 1 and 2 receive fruit in school). All children should have a water bottle in school each day (strictly no fizzy drink permitted).

## **PLEASE REMEMBER WE ARE A NUT FREE SCHOOL**

## **Universal Infant Free School Meals & Pupil Premium**

All Key Stage 1 (Reception, Year 1 and 2) pupils are entitled to receive a free school meal. This is part of the Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) initiative and regardless of what benefits, if any, are being claimed. However, some children in these year groups may also have an entitlement to benefits related Free School Meals. Children in this group are also eligible for Pupil Premium - additional funding paid to school. It is important to apply for benefits related FSM if you think your child may be eligible. You can check eligibility criteria [here](#). Children in Years 3 and above can also check criteria and apply on this link. This funding also opens up other extras such as free music lessons, holiday clubs and previously, additional help such as the cost of living payments etc.
