

Scarlet Fever

We have had a confirmed case (by GP) of Scarlet Fever. Initial symptoms usually include a sore throat, headache and a high temperature (38.3C/101F or above), flushed cheeks and a swollen tongue. <u>Introduction.aspx</u> Children prescribed antibiotics can return to school if they feel well enough 24 hours after starting their treatment. Without antibiotic treatment your child will be infectious for 1-2 weeks after symptoms appear.
