# Universal free infant school meals

You should be aware that all Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children are entitled to receive a free school meal. After the Christmas break we return to Week 1 of the Autumn/Winter menu. Chartwells will cater for all children whatever their dietary needs: if your child needs the menu adapted eg: lactose free, no diary etc please let the school office know asap so that arrangements can be made.

Whilst all Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 children receive a free meal automatically, any parent (from Years R to 6) meeting the criteria detailed should apply to Cornwall Council to apply for pupil premium. If you receive any of the following you may qualify:

- Income Support (IS)
- Income-Based jobseeker's allowance (not contribution based)
  Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (not contribution based)
- Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an Annual income of no more than £16,190.
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit (GPC)
- Support via Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA)
- Universal Credit

Please note, if you are in receipt of working tax credit, you do not qualify.
