 Fun run: 14th June: Mullion

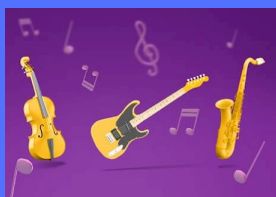


## Porthleven Arts Festival

## Music lessons

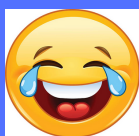
