## Is your child eligible for subsidised or free music lessons?

## Cornwall Music **Education Hub**

The Cornwall Music Education Hub is committed to ensuring wider access to music for all children and young people. In order to do this, the Hub is working with schools to help provide free or subsidised instrumental/vocal tuition for school-age children if they meet one of the following criteria:

- Currently eligible for Free School Meals (entitled to 100% subsidy, up to £5.00 per lesson)
- Currently in care (entitled to 100% subsidy, up to £5.00 per lesson)
- One or more parents are currently serving in the British armed forces (entitled to 100% subsidy, up to £5.00 per lesson)
- Parent or child is in receipt of Disability Living Allowance (entitled to 50% subsidy, up to £2.50 per lesson)

If you think that you would be eligible for music lesson subsidies, please speak to your school to discuss.

Lessons must be delivered by providers who have been approved by the Cornwall Music Education Hub as meeting standards relating to quality and safeguarding.

There are also subsidies available for instrument hire and orchestra/choir/ensemble membership.
