Pupil Premium & Service Children

Parents of children in Nursery to Year 6 should check if your child is eligible for this funding as this will provide additional money to support them in school. Full information can be found on Cornwall Council's free school meals webpage. **If you meet the criteria, please apply as soon as possible as claims cannot be backdated and can take up to ten days to process.**

Please note if your child already receives pupil premium free school meals you do not need to reapply. Parents of children in years R, Year 1 and 2 receiving universal infant free school meals should apply if entitled.
