Eden Project - whole school trip this Thursday

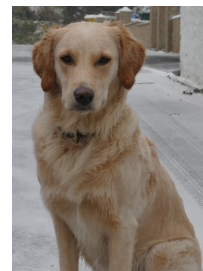
Special awards presented last Friday
