Universal Infant Free School Meals - R, Yr 1 & Yr 2

ALL children in Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 have had a Chartwells provided meal each day this week. We have been very pleased with the children, who most days, have chosen a hot meal option. The bubble staff are keeping a close eye to ensure that children have eaten sufficiently and allowing them to have some of the packed lunch supplement that you send in if they haven't eaten much. It is great to see children trying different things and tucking into something that "normally they don't eat!"

Consent and data forms

Duplicates of all outstanding consent forms were sent home this week. Please could you sign and return if you have received a duplicate please? Thank you.

Absence from school

If your child is absent from school for <u>any</u> reason <u>please</u> notify the school office as early in the school day as <u>possible</u> and for every day that they remain unwell. This may be done in person, by telephone (please confirm in writing) or by email (<u>secretary@breage.cornwall.sch.uk</u>). Please adhere to the 48-hour rule for any sickness and diarrhoea to prevent spread and please remain vigilant and follow guidelines if a member of your family or your child displays any symptoms of Covid. Our recommendation is if your child, or a member of their household is displaying symptoms of Covid, please seek advice from your GP or NHS Direct who will go through the symptoms and advise if a test is necessary. Please advise school as soon as possible if a test has been recommended/done as we have paperwork to submit to Cornwall Council. Thank you.

Reading

Reading regularly and the improvements which come from that are the back bone of young children's education. We are lucky that so many of our children are supported to read regularly at home. We ask that this happens 5 times a week **every** week as it supports children in developing a love of reading. It also gives you regular quality 1 to 1 time with your child - who wouldn't want that?

Please can we remind you that in Yellow and Blue class, when a child has completed a book, please return it on a Friday. They should have enough reading material to cover each week, but if your child is flying through books, please let us know and we can send more home. In Red class, due to the short books, we are now able to accept books back on any day. It is really important for those youngest children we keep their reading fresh and exciting.

Harvest Festival collection



In conjunction with Breage Church, we are collecting food items to support the Helston & Lizard Foodbank during this harvest time. Please deliver any non-perishable items to the main office where they

can be placed in the box provided to be sent to this much needed charity. Did you know that over 90% of the food distributed by foodbanks is donated by the public? Items most needed by the Helston & Lizard Foodbank are: tinned custard, tinned rice pudding, sponge puddings, tinned fruit, table sauces, packet mash. Currently their website shows they have plenty of baked beans, dried pasta and pasta sauces. Other suggested items are tinned meat, tinned veg, tea, coffee, biscuits, snacks, soup and rice.

Medication in school / Allergies etc

Please ensure that any medication required regularly is kept in school eg: asthma inhalers, anti-histamine etc. Should your child need to take any other medication during the school day, please ensure that a "permission to give medication on your behalf form" is completed and the medicine supplied.

Chartwells will cater for all children whatever their dietary needs: if your child needs the menu adapted eg: lactose free, no diary etc please let the school office know asap so that arrangements can be made. Full details on the school website under "school meals".

Please ensure that no sweets, chocolate, tins (pop) or glass bottles are included in packed lunches. Under Cornwall Council's fruit scheme all Reception, Year 1 and 2's are

entitled to a free piece of fruit or vegetable every day which is provided in school (seasonal). We encourage all children to have a piece of fruit during morning break and would ask that children in Years 3 to 6 bring a piece of fruit each day.
