### Headlice - please be vigilant and check hair regularly

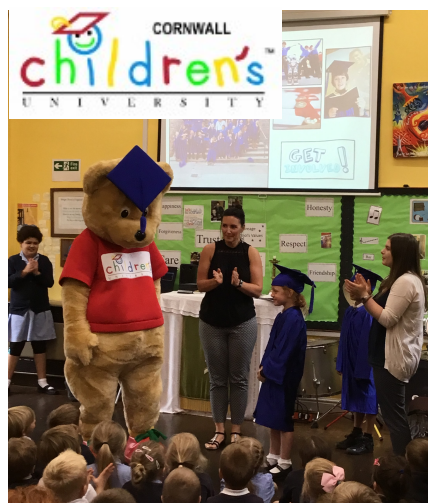
