ROAD SAFETY

Thank you for your co-operation and understanding following the changes to drop off and collection arrangements. A member of staff will be outside each morning to see children into school. The pedestrian gate will be unlocked at 8.40am and locked at 8.55am. After this time, children can enter through the main office door. This allows for teaching staff to complete registration and start lessons promptly at 9.00am. Please do not park or stop on the yellow zig zags (no matter how briefly) - this area MUST be kept clear at all times to make it safer for pedestrians. Thank you.

CLASS REQUESTS


- Red Class need empty yoghurt pots to make bird feeders please.
